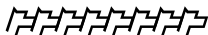
NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. **DAY PARKING** is provided and facilitated and managed by the **CCCKC**. Handicapped parking is available and typically provides an appropriate surface to the facilities; it is not necessarily closer to the building or the rings. Illegally parked cars may be ticketed and/or towed. Fines & tickets are issued through the city of Woodland. All parking fees are collected by **CCCKC**.
Parking fees are: Single Day parking: \$10.00 - CASH ONLY.
2. **BUILDING OCCUPANCY:** Dogs must be removed from ALL BUILDINGS every evening by 9:30 P.M.
3. **CRATES AND SETUPS** must be kept at least 10 feet from all rings and removed immediately after showing.
4. **EXERCISE PENS** are not allowed in any of the buildings where dogs are being exhibited.
5. **CLEANING UP** after your own dogs is your responsibility. These are Self-Cleaning shows. If your dog soils the grounds, it is your responsibility to clean it up. There will be buckets with bleach and pooper-scoopers on the grounds. By signing the entry form for these shows, you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility.
6. **DOG WASHING** on the Fairgrounds. The 1996 Clean Water Act is enforced at the Yolo County Fairgrounds. All gray water (soapy water from washing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be leveled against offenders. As a service to our exhibitors, we will offer a dog wash area located at the Beef & Sheep Building.
7. **FOOD AND BEVERAGE POLICY:** The Yolo County Fairgrounds has put some restrictions on the show site that we need to honor. Per Yolo County Fairgrounds: Open or Visible containers of alcohol are not permitted at any time in or around the show rings or buildings, and are subject to being confiscated by Fairground Personnel. If your club is holding a luncheon, after show get together, etc., they may do so if it is a potluck.
8. **TROPHIES** must be picked up each day of the shows. None will be mailed.

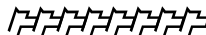

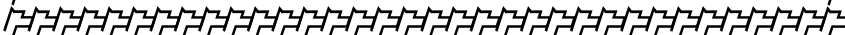

All Health Clinics To be held at the Museum

BAER Clinic Saturday, June 6, 2026

D. Colette Williams, PhD, University of CA Davis, with 40 plus years of experience in electrophysiology, will be available from 10:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. to perform BAER (Brainstem Auditory Evoked Response) testing. This is the only accepted method of diagnosis for hearing loss. The test is painless and without sedation. Dogs **must be at least 35 days old** to have the test be OFA acceptable. One test suffices for the lifetime of the animal. **Cost: \$80.00 Cash/Credit/PayPal/Venmo/Zelle per dog on a first come first served basis.** For registration in the OFA Congenital Deafness database, please complete paperwork, including all AKC information, in advance.

All-Breed Cardiology Clinic Saturday, June 6, 2026

Certification for absence of congenital heart disease may be performed on dogs one year of age or older. Dr. Brian MacKie, DVM, DACVIM (Cardiology) will be performing the tests from 9:30 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. Cost: Auscultation \$50.00 Cash/\$60.00 Credit. Echocardiogram \$250.00 Cash/\$260.00 Credit. **NOTE:** This is a "Breeding OFA Cardiac Clinic" and medication advice will not be given and reports will not be generated. **Any animals with known heart murmurs will either be charged a full consultation fee of \$700.00 or not be seen.** This is not a clinic for animals with known heart disease. We will schedule both auscultations and echocardiograms throughout the day. We encourage you to pre-register as these clinics are very popular. This year we will only accept Visa, MasterCard or Cash. **We will not be able to accept personal checks this year.** We will attempt to accommodate all those interested in cardiac screening and will take walk-ins, the day of the clinic, as time permits. Basic OFA cardiac forms will be available or you can download/complete the OFA Cardiac form and bring the completed form to the clinic. An echocardiogram is required for the advanced cardiac application and this form will be provided at the clinic. Please bring a copy of your animal's AKC registration as well as microchip/tattoo information. Owners can choose to submit the results to OFA for a small fee to obtain their dog's OFA number. **Pre-reservations must be received by Friday, May 22, 2026.** **For reservations or additional information, please contact: woofstock.healthclinics@gmail.com**

OFA Eye Certification Registry Clinic Sunday, June 7, 2026

Dr. Sydney Edwards, DVM will be available from 9:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. (first come first serve) to perform eye examinations to detect inherited eye diseases such as cataracts, progressive retinal atrophy (PRA) and retinal dysplasia. The examination is quick and painless and is required for registration by the OFA Eye Certification Registry and Orthopedic Foundation of America (OFA). Annual examination is recommended for all dogs that are involved in a breeding program. As eye drops are applied to dilate the pupils, **it is recommended that the examination be performed after the dog has completed judging.** The effect of the eye drops (dilatation) lasts approximately 4-6 hours. Please note the drops need time to work effectively for the examination, so please plan accordingly and **allow for extra time.** **The cost of the examination is \$50.00 per dog.** We will accept **cash only, NO credit/debit cards or checks.** ****Please bring your animal's AKC registration number, registered name, and birth date with you for identification on the examination form.** Also, please note microchip number and tattoo information is required as evidence of permanent identification. General Information

There will be NO Loading/Unloading Zone available.

Due to long lines it is recommended that you allow additional time to enter through the Pay Booths.

EXHIBITORS MAY WANT TO BRING SHADE OR RAIN COVER.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS. All persons attending these shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs, their members or superintendents, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. Anyone parking in show site parking lots must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

Grooming will not be allowed in any buildings at these shows, unless so marked. Areas will be designated and marked for that purpose.

Exercise pens will not be allowed at any time in buildings.

Crates will be allowed in buildings only during the time the breed is showing. Exhibitors and/or handlers must remove their crates to make room for the next breed as soon as their breed has finished.

Some portion of the crate must be touching the wall. Exhibitors and or handlers blocking the progress in fire lanes and walkways will be requested to vacate the area immediately. Come prepared to provide for the safety and comfort of your own animals.

The kennel clubs and their officials are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these shows.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

There will be NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children each day of the shows.

Trophies must be picked up each day of the shows. Trophies will not be mailed or otherwise distributed.

THE EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows.

Motorized Vehicles and/or Scooter Rules

For those exhibitors that bring their own motorized vehicle (Golf Carts) scooter or e-bikes, either gasoline or electric powered, onto the show grounds, please be aware that we will be enforcing the following rules:

1. No unlicensed driver or children under the age of 16 will be allowed to operate any motorized vehicle on the fairgrounds.
2. For the safety of all exhibitors and dogs, and due to limited space, a speed limit of 10 mph must be observed.
3. Any liability concerning an incident is the responsibility of the individual owner of the motorized vehicle.

If the above rules are not observed, motorized vehicles will be confiscated until after Best in Show each day.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden & Spanish Water Dogs. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

Overnight parking is a privilege granted by the FAIRGROUNDS & WOOFSTOCK and they reserve the right to withdraw these privileges, without return of RV overnight parking fees or entry fees, from any person who cannot abide by or abuses these privileges or uses abusive language. Violators may be subject to event show hearings. All parking is at your own risk. The FAIRGROUNDS & WOOFSTOCK assume NO responsibility or liability for damage or loss to vehicles contents or dogs, or for vehicles towed in violation of parking laws or regulations, or by actions of regulatory officers or agents. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed at the owner's expense.

RV PARKING HOURS: Wed., June 3: 3:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M., Thurs., June 4: 6:00 A.M. to 8:00 A.M. & 3:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M.; Fri. June 5 & Sat., June 6: 6:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. & after Best In Show to 10:00 P.M.; Sun., June 7: 6:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. All vehicles must be off the grounds 1 hour after Best in Show. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. **Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and showing Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
